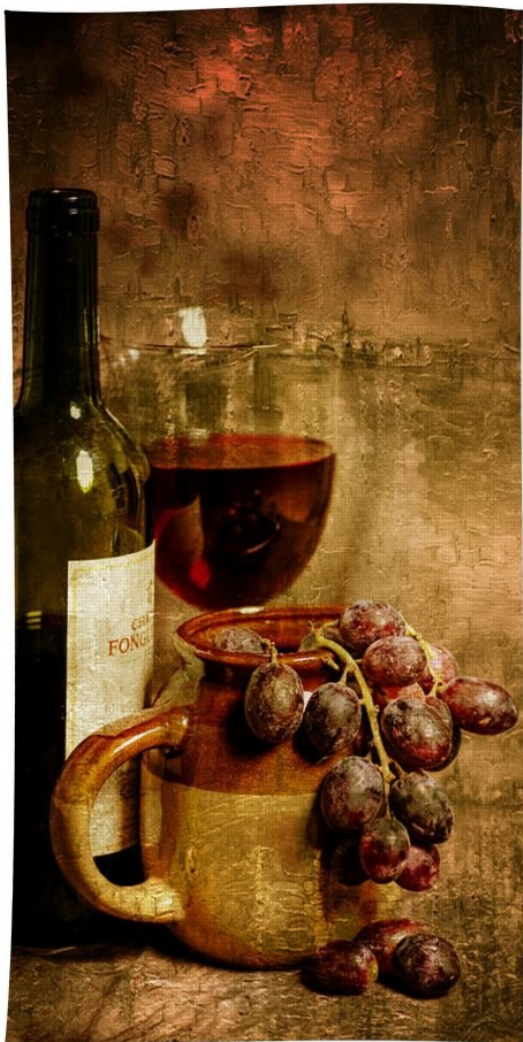

Sparkling

1: Witham Wines Elderflower Pressé

At 7% ABV this is a lighter alternative to Prosecco or Champagne, lightly sparkling and perfect for any occasion. Produced locally by a family business.

2: Giolly Prosecco

The Giol estate is one of the oldest in Italy. This individual bottle ensures every glass of Prosecco is served in perfect condition.

3: Wild Thing Prosecco

Straw coloured with gentle bubbles. Delicate apple and pear aromas and refreshing citrus fruit palate.

4: Meinklang Pinot Noir Frizzante Rosé

Austrian Pinot Noir is amongst the best in the world and this has got all the fresh red berry fruit that you would expect. Deliciously dry.

5: Witham Wines 'Methode Champenoise' Sparkling Elderflower Wine

Hand-crafted by Witham Wines of Grantham using traditional methods and whole fresh Lincolnshire elderflowers, this is a light, refreshing sparkling wine.

6: Domini Del Leone Prosecco Superiore Valdobbiadene

A drier prosecco, from the much sought after Valdobbiadene region, where the very best Glera grapes become the very best prosecco.

59: Emiliana Organic Brut, D.O. Valle Casablanca NV

Chardonnay and Pinot Noir once again work in harmony to produce the perfect balance of easy drinking freshness and yeasty toastiness. Light in colour, with fruity aromas of grapefruit, apple, pineapple, and hints of toast. The fresh palate has good body, balance, and persistence.

7: Barone Pizzini Franciacorta Animante

With Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Bianco, the bubbles aren't overly effervescent which means you can enjoy it as an apéritif or with food. Barone Pizzini, founded in 1870, is one of the oldest and best vineyards in Lombardy. Not vegan.

8: AOC Champagne Carte d'Or LS

One of the fruitier champagnes available – from Faust vineyards, which were certified organic in 1971. The Pinot Meunier grapes add fruitier flavours into the mix, bringing layers to the green apple, floral, and herbaceous flavours of the Chardonnay, giving a depth and complexity that makes it a decadent choice.

9: Wild Thing Sauvignon Blanc

Lively dry white from La Mancha, Spain. Its rich fruit flavours and balancing acidity offer a delicious drinking experience.

10: Hoopoe Pinot Grigio / Catarratto

A classic Pinot Grigio with a luscious Sicilian twist, the Catarratto adds to the apple, peach and pear flavours making for a particularly refreshing wine.

11: Stellar Limited Release NAS Colombard

This 100% Colombard (similar in style to Sauvignon Blanc) is only made in the best vintages and shows a lovely wild flower and honey nose and real tangy freshness on the finish. Fair trade production in South Africa, Stellar are experts in No Sulphur Added wines.

12: Emiliana Adobe Chardonnay Reserva

A fabulously rich tropical Chilean Chardonnay, whose persistent pineapple fruit flavours are both textured and fresh to the finish. The merest hint of oak adds subtle complexity.

13: Domaine de Pajot Le Noisette

The mid sweet Noisette is made from the best and latest picked Gros Manseng grapes from Gascony that are aged in wood.

14: Albet i Noya Petit Albet Chardonnay

This Catalan Chardonnay is unoaked to maintain maximum freshness and lightness. Pairs brilliantly with salads and lightly flavoured foods.

15: Le P'Tit Roubié Pays d'Hérault

A French assemblage of Grenache, Viognier and Sauvignon, the delicate lemon and acacia aromas are balanced with full and fruity flavours.

16: Pierre Chavin Chardonnay 5.5%

Low in alcohol at just 5.5%, this is a crystalline medium-dry Chardonnay with complex, floral aromas.

17: Viognier, Domaine de Petit Roubié

From southern France with exotic, ripe fruit and a luscious mouthfeel, it has a beautifully smooth and creamy texture.

18: Emiliana Novas Chardonnay Gran Reserva

From Chile's cool Casablanca Valley, it has plenty of tropical fruit flavours with a crisp, citrus finish. A Chardonnay to treasure and relish.

19: Château Grinou Reserve Semillon

Small volume wine, from the forward thinking, family run Grinou estate in Bergerac. Lovely, creamy, lanolin texture with flavours of pear and melon, balanced with a backbone of limey acidity.

20: Château Couronneau AOC Bordeaux Sec

This biodynamic estate, whilst better known for its excellent Merlot based reds, also produces a thrilling white of top quality. From Sauvignon Blanc and Sauvignon Gris grapes, the fermentation is carried out at low temperatures following a long maceration. This preserves all the freshness and concentration of fruit.

21: Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi

Striking citrus fruits with attractive nutty flavours for which this grape is famous. Perfect with vegetables, shellfish, rice or pasta.

22: Meinklang Grüner Veltliner

A delicate peppery flavour with a lovely zesty mineral freshness, this Austrian wine has an appealing spicy character that makes it a refreshing partner to salads and white meats.

23: Walnut Block Sauvignon Blanc

Harvested by hand in New Zealand's Marlborough region, and whole bunch pressed, this limited release Sauvignon represents the pinnacle of their vineyard.

24: Beetle Riesling Trocken

From the Mosel valley, lightly golden with green hues, green apples and citrus bouquet, and lime, kiwi and passion fruit flavours. The vineyard is a wildlife haven.

60: Côtes du Luberon Château la Canorgue Blanc 2015

This organic provençal white is a blend of Grenache, Clairette, Roussanne and Marsanne, grown at an elevated altitude which imparts a notable freshness. Pale yet fruit laden with crisp acidity and freshness. Appealing citrus aromas and uplifting apricot and white peach flavours.

61: Bonnet-Huteau Muscadet Sèvre et Main La Tarcère sur Lie

Aromatic with juicy pears, smoking shotgun shells, and sea salt. Light bodied, fresh green apple and blossom flowers. Dry with good minerality. This has good length with a minty finish.

25: Richmond Plains Blanc de Noir

Richmond Plains produced New Zealand's first organic Pinot Noir. This wine is made from hand picked grapes, having a soft texture, with peach, strawberry and floral character. Taste is full and fruity with hints of spice.

26: Sedlescombe First Release Dry

Sedlescombe is England's oldest organic vineyard. Rivaner and Bacchus varieties give the wine a fresh apple and pear bouquet, with lemongrass and grapefruit flavours.

27: Bodegas Corisca Albariño

One sip of this wine from Spain's Galicia region, and you'll detect the hallmark flavours of apricot and baked pear. A deep breath will reveal the floral aromas reminiscent of peaches, and the finish is creamy.

Rosé

28: Wild Thing Rosé

Tempranillo-based rosé from Spain. Dry yet with luscious red fruit flavours coming through to finish.

29: Stellar NAS Rosé

Our first 'No Added Sulphur' rosé, from the "no sulphur specialists" at Stellar Wineries in the Western Cape, South Africa. Shiraz-based and fair trade, this delicate pink provides plenty of lively, clean strawberry fruit flavour, that finishes smooth and dry. Best drunk young and fresh. Limited quantity.

62: Emiliana Adobe Rosé Reserva 2018

A rosé with plenty of character. This wine has a vibrant pink hue with aromas of fresh red berries. On the palate there is crunchy red fruit character; big, bold strawberry and plum fruit flavours are generous and forward, with a refreshing lemony finish making this a deliciously appealing drinking experience. 85% Syrah and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.

30: Domaine de Costebonne Mas de Longchamp Bouches du Rhône

From the Mediterranean sunshine – this fruity French rosé made with Grenache and Caladoc is all about easy-drinking pleasure.

31: Albury Silent Pool Rosé 2018

Albury Organic Vineyard, headed up by Nick Wenman is situated on the southern slopes of the North Downs near Guildford in an area of outstanding natural beauty. Biodynamic techniques are used to enhance the quality of fruit, and we're delighted to be able to offer this vintage of rosé which is only produced in tiny quantity (the first vintage was snapped up by the Queen to have on the Royal Barge for the Jubilee Celebrations in 2012).

Red

32: Stellar Shiraz NAS

A fair trade no added sulphur South African Shiraz, deep coloured with plenty of berry flavour which is nonetheless really soft and approachable.

33: Hoopoe Nero d'Avola / Syrah

Ripe and juicy, this Sicilian wine is a perfect balance of the soft, berried Nero d'Avola with the gentle spice from the Syrah.

34: Cuvée Gabriel Merlot

Excellent fruit extraction means this southern French Merlot is full of gently spiced black fruits. A soft, easy-drinking wine.

35: Emiliana Adobe Reserva Malbec

Chile is famous for its Malbec wines, and this is a classic example of what makes Chilean wines so excellent. Grown by Emiliana Organico, one of the most revered biodynamic and organic estates east of the Andes Mountains, this fair trade wine is a deep ruby red, and the first whiff will give you strong aromas of blackberries, mocha, and plums. The flavours of the wine are well-structured and long-lasting, with a palate of cherry and hints of spice and vanilla. One of the best organic Chilean wines around!

36: Pierre Chavin Cabernet Sauvignon 5.5%

Low in alcohol at just 5.5%, this is an elegant and sophisticated organic Cabernet Sauvignon. Its tasty blackberry notes make it irresistible, and thanks to its low calorie level, it provides a real feeling of lightness.

37: Le P'Tit Roubié Pays d'Hérault

An assemblage of Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, this charming southern French red has light tannins, fresh acidity and bountiful cherry and raspberry fruits with herbal nuances.

38: La Boissiere Ventoux Grenache

A Rhône-style blend of Grenache and Syrah from organic vineyards at the foot of Mont Ventoux. It's deliciously full-flavoured, full-bodied yet smooth, and has rich aromas of forest fruits and black pepper.

39: Stellar Pinotage NAS

This is a pure, fruit-filled organic wine crammed with hints of briar fruit, dark cherry and spicy liquorice aromas with a subtle note of pepper. The wine's purity will banish any pre-conceptions based upon the oft-seen rustic styles of Pinotage of yesteryear. The bright juicy blackberry flavours mingle with damson and exotic spices whilst being supported by a mantle of ripe, relaxed tannins.

40: Viña Ijalba Livor Rioja Tempranillo LS

From a Spanish vineyard that specialises in lost grape varieties, this Rioja has a beguiling raspberry jam character which has no rough edges. Smooth from start to finish, with liquorice notes.

41: Bodegas Piqueras Old Vines

Garnacha

From southeast Spain, the 'Piqueras' label is fast becoming well known for reliable high quality and great value. The older Garnacha vines here (45-60 years) provide oodles of velvety black cherry, damson and spice flavours, with hints of vanilla oak.

58: Las Niñas Syrah/Mourvèdre 2015

Exuberant but fresh, elegant but crispy, and all the time pleasant. Violet notes, red fruits, eucalyptus and mint compose the aromatic profile of this unique wine. A rare combination for Chilean viticulture that shows the terroir's ability to develop great wines from the foothills of Apalta.

42: Moinho do Gato Douro

This Portuguese unoaked and intensely fruity red is light to medium bodied. Great with steaks, beef and mushroom dishes.

43: Waverley Hills Cabernet Sauvignon NAS

Carefully hand picked and destemmed, the absence of sulphur raises the fruity, red berry and flower aromas, keeps the colour intensity and enriches and balances the palate.

44: Les Domaines Paul Mas Cuvée Secrete Pinot Noir

The tiny hamlet of Conas near the historic town of Pézenas is the cradle of Domaines Paul Mas. The Cuvée Secrete range is made of wines using ancient varietals or wines that have been made with different vinification methods. This Pinot Noir has been vinified and aged at the heart of the Limoux estate. There is a soft, cherry flavour with enough tannin and fruit to balance the wine and give length and body.

45: Minervois Old School Rouge

Unfined, unfiltered and never acidified, uses Syrah and Grenache to give an up-front pleasure-bent style, with fruit forward aromas of blackberry, black cherry, olive, pepper and wild herbs.

46: Emiliana Orgánico Salvaje Syrah / Roussanne NS

Inky purple in colour, the nose is full of ripe black fruits and earthy forest floor. Hints of pepper and nutmeg, with blueberry and blackberry. Rich and powerful, try with game or dark meats.

56: Stellar Organics Cabernet Sauvignon / Pinotage 2013 LS

Intense fruity nose, characterized by notes of elderberry, ripe juicy peach, sour cherry compote and spicy paprika, this reserve wine is straightforward, almost jam-juicy with fine well-integrated tannins.

47: La Corte del Pozzo Valpolicella

Classic Italian, characterised by red berries with a light vanilla note. The taste is dry and well balanced. Drink with turkey, beef, mushroom or meaty fish like tuna.

48: Domaine Bousquet Malbec Reserve

Domaine Bousquet combines French know-how and Argentina's exceptional climate to produce spectacular wines. This elegant Malbec is aged 10 months in French oak, well balanced with rich aromas and raspberry, cassis and fig flavours.

49: Meinklang Burgenland Pinot Noir

An irresistible Austrian wine. It's supremely succulent, soft and beetrooty and yet deliciously fresh.

50: Château Couronneau AOC Bordeaux Le Fougueux NAS 15.5%

Our best selling Bordeaux supplier has now produced their first biodynamic No Sulphur Added wine. Quite a blockbuster, its sweet and enticing strawberry fruit nose, introduces a punchy black fruit driven palate of big concentration. Very rich, and high in alcohol – a little goes a long way!

51: Domaine Richard Rottiers Beaujolais Villages La Sambinerie

A very fine Beaujolais-Villages from granite terroir situated next to the Moulin-a-Vent appellation. Carbonic maceration with three months in oak to help round the tannins. Tremendous fruit impact, all fresh cherry and blackberry, it is a very comforting wine.

52: Domaine Bousquet Ameri Single Vineyard 15%

A special wine from Tupungato in Argentina. Grapes from a single vineyard are barrel fermented then aged for 16 months in French oak barrels. A dense purple colour, with intense aromas of red and black berries, it is excellent with red meats, cheeses and chocolate.

57: Albet i Noya Reserva Marti Penedès 2009 14.5%

This wine from the oldest and most beautiful vineyards on the estate is the peak of winemaking. After fifteen years working with monovarietal wines, seeking the tannins, aromas and colours of each variety, this is the result of a quest for a more complex wine. This muscular red offers dried cherry, tobacco, leather and woody flavors backed by solid tannins and balsamic acidity. There's good concentration, and enough freshness to keep this balanced. Tempranillo, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Only 500 cases are made each year.

Dessert wines

53: Stellar Heaven On Earth Sweet Muscat 11%

The effect of drying the Muscat grapes on a bed of straw and rooibos tea is added flavour as well as intensity. What's not lost is Muscat's natural acidity and this keeps the wine deliciously fresh. A great way to kick-start an evening with friends or take with a mild blue cheese at the end of dinner. Fair trade.

54: Château Dudon Sauternes 13.5%

From an independent family run estate in the Barsac area, not far from the legendary Château Yquem. Produced from yield restricted plots of Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc and a tiny amount of Muscadelle, this oak aged beauty will keep forever. Deeply honeyed and opulent, yet with bright acidity, a real treat on it's own or to partner rich paté, blue cheese or sweet desserts.

55: Domaine Bousquet Fortified Malbec 18%

A four month-long maceration ensures that the maximum amount of flavour has been extracted from the skins of the Malbec grapes. This late-harvested Malbec undergoes a lengthy fermentation and is aged in French oak. Intense aromas of blackberry, cassis and coffee. Silky tannins. Good natural acidity is an essential factor in quality sweet wines and there's just the right amount here to keep in check the layers of plum fruits, chocolate, coffee, caramel, spice and marmalade flavours you'll find here. A delicious way to end dinner.
